SOUTH

- Agriculture...plantations and small farms



How did the Industrial Revolution affect people living in this region of the United States?

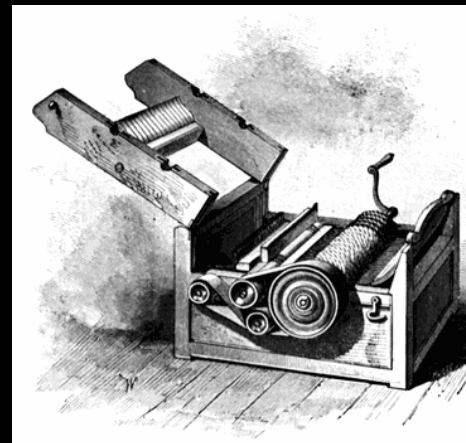
NORTH

- More technology
- Development of Factories and Railroads



SOUTH

- Very little change
- The Cotton Gin increased slavery in the South

How did most people living in this region feel about change and “progress”?

NORTH

- Progressive – most people embraced change (they liked it!)



SOUTH

- Conservative – most people resisted change (they liked life the way it was!)



Is the U.S. Constitution a “contract between states” or an “agreement between states”?

NORTH

- All the states that signed the U.S. Constitution in 1787 signed a legally binding CONTRACT!



SOUTH

- All the states joined the United States voluntarily...they could therefore leave voluntarily...it was an AGREEMENT!
